

Husson University invites applications for two 9-month, full-time, faculty positions within the Physical Therapy Department of the School of Health. Requirements for these positions include completion of an academic doctoral degree (Ph.D., Ed.D., D.Sc.) in physical therapy, or related field. Consideration will be given to doctoral students in the dissertation phase of their degree.

Position 1: Teaching responsibilities will be concentrated in the area of cardiopulmonary physical therapy and exercise physiology.

Position 2: Teaching responsibilities include two of the following areas: acute care, neuro, peds, and healthcare policy and administration.

Both positions require active participation in scholarly activity, and professional service. Candidates should have a record of teaching experience and a minimum of three years of clinical experience.

Salary and rank are commensurate with qualifications and experience.

The anticipated starting date for both positions is August 27, 2009. Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the positions are filled.

Husson University's primary campus is located in Bangor, Maine which has a city population of approximately 35,000 residents, but serves a much larger region in northern and eastern Maine of approximately 100,000 people. Bangor is located on the beautiful Penobscot River, and is a short drive from the coast of the Atlantic Ocean, Acadia National Park, the Northern Woods of Maine, and Baxter State Park.
